

Redcar CC April Results Summary

We started our return to the NYSD Premier Division 2013 campaign led by our new erudite Skipper Tom Urwin and vice captain evergreen Mick McCabe taking on Stokesley away. We went into the game after a pre-season friendly victory against a strong Guisborough 1st team in which Tom Urwin and Sam Berry scored half centuries. However at Stokesley we were dismissed for 98 with new Pro Mohammed Saad desperately unlucky to be run out backing up. The only resistance came from youngsters Tyler Easton (22) and Sam Berry (25). Stokesley made light of victory despite Mohammed Zahid's fine 10 over spell of 1-5 as they finished on 101-1. Our second fixture was at home to Guisborough and we fared even worse and were all out for 65 with Guisbro' Pro Dhammika taking 4-9. They knocked off the target with the loss of 3 wkts. Mohammed Zahid bowling an exceptional spell of 10 overs taking 2-18. Ex Redcar stalwart Martin Hood was unbeaten on 20 at the close for Guisborough. It doesn't get any easier as our next 2 games are away to Champions Richmond and then last year's runners up Darlington.

Our 2nds opened their account with a victory over Stokesley 2nds. Chasing 147 to win we looked in trouble at 88-8 but Skipper Steve Law (20no) stayed with Billy Hodgson (39no) and their 59 run unbeaten partnership saw us home. Earlier Dave Corps took 6-43 and Man of the Match Billy Hodgson 3-14. We continued our good form with an excellent victory over a chewy Marske eleven who made 159-9. Andrew "Hoss" Hunter was the star of the show with 7-71. At 80-5 things were in the balance but a stand of 67 between Mitchell Brown (52 no) and Rob Munro (22) saw us home by 4 wkts aided also by a chirpy 33 (7 4's) from swashbuckling Jonathon Cooper.
