# **Redcar CC August Monthly Summary**

1st X1 August campaign began with yet another rain effected draw v Darlington RA who made 28-4 before the match was abandoned. We then drew at Guisborough in a close fought battle. After his miraculous recovery from his wrist injury Tyler Easton saved us again with a stylish 83 out of 189 all out. Guisborough made 176-7 in reply with a welcome return to form by Shaggy McGarry with 3-38. The following week we were matched with Guisborough again at home and surprisingly lost by 34 runs after hey made 217-6. We were looking good on 174-4 but inexplicably lost our last 6 wkts for 12 runs including three ludicrous run outs and finished 186 all out. We were then washed out in the "Big One" at Bishop Auckland. On Bank Holiday Monday we beat Marton by 8 wkts after Callum Brown span his web taking 5-27 in their total of 130 all out. Tyler steered us home with 35 not out. By the end of the month our promotion hopes were looking slim until Bishop Auckland were sensationally defeated by Marske 2nds. This means that with 3 games left Saltburn have won promotion already but Bishop Auckland are only 4 points ahead of us and they play Champions Saltburn home and away as their last 2 games! We play Blackhall away, Marske 2nds home and Whitby away so it should be a fight to the finish for the other promotion spot.
