1st X1 July campaign began with a disappointing defeat at home to Saltburn. The game went ahead due to the hard work of our outstanding groundsman Steve Knight. On a slow wicket and outfield we made 135. We were set for a decent total in difficult conditions at 66-1 with Tyler Easton and Ben Hutchinson in little trouble but the unfortunate run out of Ben proved the turning point. Saltburn batted solidly and lost 5 wkts in their chase which took 45 overs, Callum Brown continued his excellent form with 3-41. We then beat Marske by 5 wkts, Tyler Easton showing how good he is with a match-winning 56 not out on a difficult wicket. The villagers made 112 all out, Mick McCabe holding back the years with 4-24. At Seaton Carew they made 200 with "Ralph Malph" Rix taking 5-26. We battled against a strong attack and ended on 166-6 thanks to in-form Tyler Easton's 50. We then beat Northallerton away.
